CONVOCATION 190th SESSION OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL OF THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY UNION Kampala, 1 and 5 April 2012

Dear Madam, Dear Sir,

We have pleasure in informing you that the Governing Council of the Inter-Parliamentary Union will hold its 190th session at the Kampala Serena Conference Centre (KSCC).

The Governing Council will hold a first sitting from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. on Sunday, 1^{st} April. Its second sitting will take place from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, 5 April.

1. PARTICIPATION

The Governing Council is composed of three members from each parliament represented in the IPU^* .

In accordance with Governing Council Rule 2, "a member of the Governing Council who is unable to attend may be replaced by another representative of the Union Member in question duly authorized for that purpose". The IPU Secretariat should be notified accordingly.

^{*} Each parliament's representation on the Governing Council must include both men and women. Single gender delegations will be limited to two members (Rule 1.2 of the Rules of the Governing Council).

2. **PROVISIONAL AGENDA**

The provisional agenda for the session, prepared by the Executive Committee at its 262nd session (October 2011) session, is as follows:

The Governing Council will adopt its agenda at the beginning of its proceedings.

3. SUPPLEMENTARY ITEMS

In conformity with Governing Council Rule 13, members of the Council may request the inclusion of supplementary items in the agenda. Such items must fall within the competence of the Council which, according to Article 20.1 of the Statutes, determines and guides the activities of the Union and controls their implementation.

Any requests for the inclusion of supplementary items will be immediately transmitted by the Secretariat to all Council members. After hearing the opinion of the Executive Committee, the Council shall decide on such a request by a majority of votes cast if the request is received by the Secretariat at least 15 days before the opening of the session; otherwise by a two-thirds majority.

4. DOCUMENTS

To the extent possible, working documents regarding various items of the provisional agenda will be sent out to Members and posted on the IPU website in advance.
