Convocation of the 195th session of the Governing Council of the IPU

Geneva, 13 and 16 October 2014

Madam President, Mr. President,

We have pleasure in informing you that the Governing Council of the Inter-Parliamentary Union will hold its 195th session at the *Centre international de Conférences de Genève (CICG)*, in Geneva.

1. PARTICIPATION

The Governing Council is composed of three members from each parliament represented in the IPU. Each parliament's representation on the Governing Council must include both men and women. Single-gender delegations will be limited to two members (Rule 1.2 of the Rules of the Governing Council).

2. PROCEEDINGS OF THE SESSION

The first sitting of the Governing Council will take place on Monday, 13 October, from 9 to 10.45 a.m., and will start by examining items 1 to 6. It will then receive a presentation of the draft *Programme and Budget for 2015* (item 7).

At its second sitting, to be held on Thursday, 16 October, from 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m., the Governing Council will start by electing the new President of the IPU and then continue with other business, including the adoption of the *draft Programme and Budget for 2015*. At its third sitting, to be held in the afternoon of the same day, from 2.30 to 5.30 p.m., the Governing Council will examine all remaining items on its agenda.

The Governing Council will elect two members to replace Ms. S. Moulengui-Mouélé (Gabon) and Ms. S. Ataullahjan (Canada), whose terms of office expire at the time of the 195th session of the Governing Council.

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4. **SUPPLEMENTARY ITEMS**

In conformity with Governing Council Rule 13, members of the Council may request the inclusion of supplementary items in the agenda. Such items must fall within the competence of the Council which, according to Article 20 of the Statutes, determines and guides the activities of the IPU and controls their implementation.

Any requests for the inclusion of supplementary items will be immediately transmitted by the Secretariat to all Council members. After hearing the opinion of the Executive Committee, the Council shall decide on such a request by a majority of votes cast if the request is received by the Secretariat at least 15 days before the opening of the session; otherwise by a two-thirds majority.

5. **DOCUMENTS**

To the extent possible, working documents regarding various items of the provisional agenda will be sent out to Members and posted on the IPU website in advance.
