According to the gender guidelines governing the composition of the Committee on Middle East Questions, the three titular members cannot all be of the same gender. The substitute member should be a woman parliamentarian.
Moreover, the members shall be elected on the basis of their interest and expertise in the subject matter and of their availability to attend all sessions.

On 24 October, the Governing Council will be required to elect three titular members (Arab Group, Eurasia Group and Latin America and Caribbean Group) and two substitute members (Arab Group and Asia-Pacific Group).
