The Forum will also be required to elect one Board member (female) from the <u>Twelve</u> <u>Plus Group</u> to replace Ms. M. Lugarić (Croatia) and one Board member (male) from the <u>Arab Group</u> to replace Mr. F. Al-Tenaiji (United Arab Emirates): neither is a member of parliament any longer.

#### 3. Contribution to the work of the 134<sup>th</sup> Assembly

Members of the Forum will define their input to the General Debate of the 134<sup>th</sup> Assembly – *Rejuvenating democracy, giving voice to youth.* 

The Members will also share their views from a youth perspective on the draft resolutions under consideration at the 134<sup>th</sup> Assembly entitled:

- Terrorism: The need to enhance global cooperation against the threat to democracy and individual rights by the Standing Committee on Peace and International Security; and

- Ensuring lasting protection against destruction and deterioration for the tangible and intangible cultural heritage of humanity by the Standing Committee on Sustainable Development, Finance and Trade
