## Amendments to the IPU Statutes and Rules

## Sub-amendments submitted by the delegation of France within the statutory deadline of six weeks before the meeting of the Assembly

Modify the original amendment as follows:

Modify the original amendment as follows: ${ }^{\text { }}$

| Article 25.2 | 2. The President of the Inter-Parliamentary Union shall be ex <br> officio President of the Executive Committee. Fifteen members <br> shall be elected by the Governing Council; not less than 12 shall be <br> elected from among the members of the Governing Council to <br> which they shall continue to belong during their mandate. At least <br> three of the members elected must be women. Each sex shall be <br> represented by no less than 30 per cent one third of the <br> elected members. |

## Comment:

As there are 15 elected members, it is preferable to provide that one-third of that number, i.e. five, is of the less represented sex, rather than to refer to 30 per cent, which equals 4.5 members.
