4. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

In order to facilitate the welcome service at the Nnamdi Azikiwe International Airport in Abuja, all participants are asked to provide the details of their arrival and departure (date, time, flight no., etc.) on the hotel reservation form.

A welcome service will be set up at the airport from **8 to 11 June 2012**. This service will provide assistance for formalities and transfers from the airport to the hotels. It will also handle transfers from the hotels to the airport at the end of the Seminar.

5. VISAS

In cases where a visa is required for entry into Nigeria, one will be issued to delegates free of charge by the diplomatic or consular representations of Nigeria.

Exceptionally, visas can be issued to delegates upon their arrival at the Nnamdi Azikiwe International Airport in Abuja in cases where there is no diplomatic or consular representation of Benin in their country. Delegates are kindly asked to communicate to the Seminar Organizing Committee, at least two weeks before they arrive in Nigeria, their passport number and type, flight number and date and time of arrival in Abuja.

6. VACCINES AND HEALTH

Delegates will be required to present a vaccination certificate upon entering the country. Participants are also advised to take precautions against malaria. Please seek the advice of your medical physician concerning vaccines.

During the seminar, a first aid medical service will be provided. Any other medical services or treatment will be at the participants' expense.

7. LUGGAGE TAGS AND STICKERS

A special service will be entrusted with handling participants' luggage.

8. REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION OFFICE

A registration and information office will be available to participants during the seminar from 8 to 11 June 2012. It will be open from 8 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 3 to 5.30 p.m. Participants are invited to register with this office as soon as they arrive. They will be provided with an identity badge and any other information related to the seminar that they may require. It will also receive messages and deliver mail.

11. CURRENCY AND EXCHANGE

The local currency in Nigeria is the Naira (\mathbb{H}) and Kobo. The rate of exchange into naira fluctuates and is not very stable
