On behalf of our two organisations, we are pleased to invite you and members of your parliament to the <u>Parliamentary Forum on Children</u>, an important event within the UN General Assembly's Special Session on Children, which will be held in New York, 8-10 May 2002.

The Forum is being planned for the morning of Thursday, 9 May, under the joint auspices of UNICEF and the Inter-Parliamentary Union. It will be open to members of national parliaments as well as members of regional parliamentary groups interested in children's issues.

The Forum will seek legislative strategies to promote the well-being of children. In particular, we hope the parliamentarians can focus on measures to protect children's rights and mobilize resources to implement the goals set by the Special Session.
