4. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

In order to facilitate the welcome service at the Bernadin Gantin International Airport, all participants are asked to provide the details of their arrival and departure (date, time, flight no., etc.) on the hotel reservation form.

A welcome service will be set up at the airport from 22 to 25 May 2010. This service will provide assistance for formalities and transfers from the airport to the hotels. It will also handle transfers from the hotels to the airport at the end of the Conference.

5. VISAS

In cases where a visa is required for entry into Benin, one will be issued to delegates free of charge by the diplomatic or consular representations of Benin.

6. VACCINES AND HEALTH

Delegates will be required to present a vaccination certificate upon entering the country. Participants are also advised to take precautions against malaria. Please seek the advice of your medical physician concerning vaccines.

During the Conference, a first aid medical service will be provided. Any other medical services or treatment will be at the participants' expense.

7. LUGGAGE TAGS AND STICKERS

A special service will be entrusted with handling participants' luggage.

8. REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION OFFICE

A registration and information office will be available to participants during the Conference from **22 to 25 May 2010**. It will be open from 8 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 3 to 5.30 p.m. Participants are invited to register with this office as soon as they arrive.
