



# Regional Seminar on Sustainable Development Goals for Parliaments of Latin America and the Caribbean

Jointly organized by the Latin American and Caribbean Parliament (PARLATINO) and the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU)

1–2 December 2016, PARLATINO Headquarters, Panama City, Panama

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### 1. PLACE, DATE AND PROGRAMME

The seminar will be held on 1 and 2 December 2016 in the Plenary Hall at PARLATINO on the main street of Amador. Badges and seminar documents will be distributed at the entrance. The draft programme is attached.

#### 2. PARTICIPATION

The seminar is open to the following parliaments: Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Aruba, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Curacao, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Saint Kitts & Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, San Martin, Suriname, Trinidad & Tobago, Uruguay and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of). Those parliaments are invited to send a delegation that is gender balanced and that reflects the political representation in their parliament. It is recommended that delegates should have a professional connection to development issues.

#### 3. PROCEDURAL ISSUES

In keeping with IPU practice, all participants will have equal speaking rights. To make discussions as fruitful and enriching possible, the following rules shall apply:

- (a) There will be no list of speakers on any agenda item. After specialists have introduced an agenda item, the session will be open to participants for questions and comments.
- (b) Experience has shown that such meetings do not lend themselves to reading prepared statements. Oral contributions may not exceed three minutes, subject to arrangements that the Chair may make to suit the circumstances. Participants may speak several times on each subject, particularly to respond to other statements or comments.

#### 4. DOCUMENTS

Participants will receive printed copies of the presentations that will be made by experts. As far as possible, the IPU Secretariat will provide participants with documentation about the context of the issues under discussion.

#### 5. LANGUAGES

The working languages are English and Spanish.
